

Information for people from 12 years old (6th year of elementary school) to 15 years old (3rd year of junior high school)

Vouchers for 12 to 15 years old will be sent on September 29th.

We will set up a dedicated venue for inoculation of people with disabilities.

People under the age of 16 must be with their parent or guardian to be vaccinated.

Regarding accompanying guardians

[1] If a person under the age of 16 is vaccinated at a public facility vaccination site or a large-scale mass vaccination site, they must be accompanied by a guardian.

[2] When inoculating, the guardian must sign their name on the signature line of the pre-examination slip.

[3] You will not be vaccinated without the signature of your guardian on the pre-examination slip.

[4] "Guardian" means a person who has custody or is a guardian under the Immunization Law. Generally, this is considered fathers and mothers who are raising children.

[5] Of those who are not parents (grandparents, etc.), only those who are familiar with the health conditions of the child to be inoculated are allowed to accompany them.

[6] A "Covid-19 vaccination power of attorney" is required when accompanied by a person other than a guardian.

Inoculation tickets bulk mailed (for those born between April 2, 2006 and November 1, 2009)

- September 29th (Wednesday)

You must be at least 12 years old on the day of inoculation. If you are 11 years old, please make a reservation for after the day before your birthday.

For those born between November 2, 2009 and February 1, 2010, an inoculation ticket will be sent in early November, 2021 (scheduled).

How to make reservations for public facility type inoculation venues and large-scale mass inoculation venues

We do not make vaccination reservations at city hall, branch offices, or health centers, etc.

1. How to make a reservation

Please make your reservation from the call center or the reservation site described in the guide text enclosed with your vaccination ticket.

Either way, you can make a reservation only if there is an open reservation slot.

Inoculation for people with disabilities

Overview

1. Target

Persons aged 12 (6th year of elementary school) to 15 (3rd year of junior high school) who live in the city and attend day services such as after school programs

2. Dedicated venue

Okazaki City Integrated Study Center (Ueji 3-chome)

3. Vaccine to be inoculate with

Pfizer vaccine

4. Inoculation time (planned)

- First time: Mid to late October
- Second time: Early to mid-November
