- Recycling stations are managed by neighbourhood associations
- Follow these 3 rules to keep the recycling stations clean



Use the bags designated by Okazaki City!

There are 5 types of bags: one for each type of trash Non-designated bags (such as grocery bags) cannot be used















Put out the trash by 8:30am on the designated collection day





Designated days for each type of trash vary based on the area you live



Separate your trash and bring it to the correct recycling station!

Recycling stations are assigned based on one's address.

If uncertain, please ask a neighbour or your management company





When disposing of a TV, fridge/freezer, washing machine/ dryer, or air conditioning unit, you must pay a recycling fee.

Make a request to retail electronics store
