Wouldn't it be great for children to communicate well in both their native tongue and Japanese while enjoying life and studies in Japan?

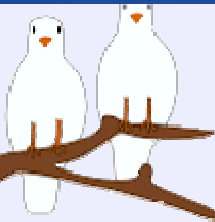
Let's talk healthy eating habits — mingle with Japanese families while considering this topic!
